NRO NC Election November 2023



- Three seats on the Number Resource Organization Number Council (NRO NC) are filled by RIPE representatives:
 - Two seats are filled by election
 - One seat by a RIPE NCC Executive Board appointment
- This is election is to fill the seat for the term started by James Kennedy in January 2023, and ending on December 2025
- Hervé Clément has been appointed by the RIPE NCC Executive Board for a three-year term from January 2024 - December 2026

Voter Registration and Eligibility





You must have registered for RIPE 87 and to vote in the NRO NC election



You must check-in ahead of the voting registration deadline



You must have attended at least one of the previous eight RIPE Meetings

Register to Vote



- You must have registered for RIPE 87 and to vote in the NRO NC election
- You must check-in ahead of the voting registration deadline
- You must have attended at least one of the previous eight RIPE Meetings

- Register for RIPE 87 (online or onsite)
- Select the option to vote in the NRO NC
 Election
- If you forgot this step during registration:
 - ONSITE: Go to the Registration desk
 - ONLINE: Go to your personal options page and select the option to vote

Deadline: Tuesday, 28 November at 14:00 UTC+1

Check In



- You must have registered for RIPE 87 and to vote in the NRO NC election
- You must check-in ahead of the voting registration deadline
- You must have attended at least one of the previous eight RIPE Meetings

- Checked in attendees have a green tick mark next to their names on the attendee list:
 - https://ripe87.ripe.net/attend/attendee-list/
- The system automatically removes all those who have not checked-in by the deadline
- If you're unsure:
 - ONSITE: Go to the Registration desk
 - ONLINE: Go to your personal options page and select the option to check in

Deadline: Tuesday, 28 November at 14:00 UTC+1

Eligibility



- You must have registered for RIPE 87 and to vote in the NRO NC election
- You must check-in ahead of the voting registration deadline
- You must have attended at least one of the previous eight RIPE Meetings

- You must have attended one of the previous eight RIPE Meetings i.e. RIPE 79 to RIPE 86, online or onsite
- Those ineligible will receive an email from the RIPE NCC
 - If you think you are eligible to vote but you received this email, ask for a review
 - The link to the review form is in the email!
- Not eligible at RIPE 87? Keep an eye out for the elections at RIPE 89!

Results



- Results will be announced during the Closing Plenary taking place on Friday, 1 December 2023
- The candidate with the most votes will be elected



Voting

How to Vote



- You will receive two emails from Assembly Voting
- One email contains your personalised link to the third-party voting platform with a pre-filled code (Voting Code 1)
- The other email contains your one-time voting pincode (Voting Code 2)
- You need both to access the voting system!
- Select the candidate of your choice
- Abstentions are noted, but do not count towards the results

Please select the candidate of your choice or ABSTAIN to ensure that your vote is registered. If you leave the platform before submitting your vote and confirming on the vote summary page, your vote will not be registered.








- Voting Code 1 is pre-filled (you might need to enter it if you use Safari or a password manager)

Submit Your Vote






- Select the candidate of your choice (or abstain)
